

Privacy Policy

Link Logistics Real Estate LLC (“Link”) respects your concerns about privacy and is committed to maintaining the trust of our affiliated entities and clients (collectively, the “Link Clients” or “Clients”) and the visitors to the Link website at <https://www.linklogistics.com/> (such website visitors, the “Visitors”, and such website, the “Link Website”). This privacy policy (“Privacy Policy”) describes how Link collects and uses our Visitors’ personal information and also describes our practices regarding personal information that we collect on behalf of our Clients.

Link may collect personal information in two ways. First, Link acts as a service provider to our Clients, and we may collect personal information in connection with our provision of services to our Clients (such services, the “Link Services” or “Services”, and such personal information, the “Client Data”). Second, Link may collect limited personal information from our Visitors to the Link Website. More information regarding each of these is described below.

For purposes of this Privacy Policy, “personal information” is data about you or that can reasonably be used to identify you.

I. Personal information collected from the link website

When you visit the Link Website, we collect limited personal information from you with respect to your visit, as described below (the “Website Information”):

Online Activity Information on the Link Website, Including, but not limited to, IP address, browser type, device type, network location, browser language, operating system, referral sources, pages viewed on the Link Website, and your usage of the Link Website, links clicked/opened in Link emails

Categories of Source(s) from which Personal Information is Collected

From your use of the Link Website, this information is automatically collected when you visit the Link Website through the use of browser information and web server log files and JavaScript

Business or Commercial Purpose(s) for which Personal Information is Collected or Used

- To provide you with the Link Website
- To improve the Link Website, including statistical analysis of the Link Website
- To operate, evaluate, and improve Link’s products and services
- To respond to customer inquiries

- For our IT or security purposes

Categories of Third Parties with whom Personal Information is Shared

Link may share this information with our service providers who are performing services on our behalf. Additionally, we may share this information (i) if we are required to do so by law or legal process, (ii) to law enforcement authorities, regulators, and/or other government entities and/or competent authorities based on lawful disclosure, or (iii) when we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to prevent harm or financial loss, or in connection with an investigation of suspected or actual fraudulent or illegal activity.

Cookies and Web beacons, including both first and third party cookies.

Categories of Source(s) from which Personal Information is Collected

- From cookies, which are bits of text that can be placed on your computer's hard drive when you visit certain websites.
- From web beacons, which are small files that link web pages to particular web servers and their cookies.

Business or Commercial Purpose(s) for which Personal Information is Collected

- To customize our Visitors' visit to the Link Website.
- To deliver content tailored to our Visitors' interests and the manner in which our Visitors browse the Link website.
- To manage the Link website.

In addition to the uses described above, Link may also use or share your personal information

- To comply with applicable laws and regulatory requirements, or as requested by government or regulatory authorities;
- In connection with a merger, divestiture, acquisition, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by us is among the assets transferred;
- To detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity, and prosecute those responsible for that activity;
- To debug to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality in the Link Website.

II. No sale of personal information

Link does not sell your personal information to non-affiliated third parties (including for their own direct marketing purposes) without your consent. In addition, Link has not sold your personal information to non-affiliated third parties in the last 12 months. If you are entitled to any disclosure rights in your jurisdiction regarding our sale of your personal

information to non-affiliated third parties or our disclosure of your personal information to third parties for their own direct marketing purposes, this disclosure satisfies those requirements. III. Tracking; third party analytics providers

Link may use third-party analytics providers on the Link Website, such as Google Analytics. These service providers help us analyze how Visitors use the Link Website. For example, Google Analytics provides us with certain data regarding the demographics of the users that visit the Link Website. To provide this service, Google Analytics may collect certain information about you from your computer, including through the use of cookies. Such information may include information regarding your visit (such as the pages you visit and the length of your visit), information about your device (such as your IP address), how you got to the Link Website, and other information about you. By using the Link Website and providing any information through the Link Website, you consent to the transfer of your information and personal information among the facilities in these countries, including those located outside your home country. Do not use the Link Website if you do not want your personal information to be transferred to the United States or to other countries, or if the laws in your country restrict these types of transfers.
